The NILS Meeting 2010 will be held in Madrid, Spain, on January 21 and 22, 2010.

The aims of the NILS Meeting are

- To identify research institutions, academic institutions and individuals in involved countries (Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Spain), working in experimental sciences, or in any discipline with a relevant mathematical content, that could be interested in joining collaboration schemes.
- To exchange about common research interests that could lead to joint collaboration.
- To forecast and to plan, if possible, specific cooperation activities that could be financed in the frame of NILS project (the third call for applications will probably be launched on January 2, 2010).

The scientific programme of the Meeting will consist on invited talks, contributed communications and/or posters.

- Opening session with a few words by a UCM representative and a representative from Norway
- Two/Three invited lectures given by people able to present a broad outline of research on Mathematics or Experimental sciences
- A panel discussion on possible scientific interactions

January 22, Friday

Morning (9:30 h. to 13h.)

- Two/Three invited lectures given by people able to present a broad outline of research on Experimental sciences

- Panel discussion on possible scientific interactions within the NILS frame
- Technical aspects on possible collaboration in this framework. Third call for proposals to be open during January – February 2010
