SHORT GUIDE FOR THE APPLICANT

The Call: Main Features

Application deadline: February 28

Stays: Must start not before May 2010, and finish no later than March 2011

Spanish host/sending institution: Must fund 15% of the total cost of the grant (including monthly

allowance and travel costs)

Length of stays: Up to 6 months for Seniors

During their stay grantees will collaborate with the local research groups pertaining to the field of Arts. The Chair aims to contribute to launch new research lines in collaboration with Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein as well as to strengthen the existing ones.
