STEP ONE (GETTING A RAMON Y CAJAL POSITION FOR 5 YEARS)

- 1. You hold a PhD between Jan 2007 and Dec 2014 (exceptions apply).
- 2. You have been a postdoc (not Juan de la Cierva) for at least two years (exceptions apply).
- 3. You have a good CV (recent examples: Cubero FJ, Redondo-Muñoz J, Iborra S).
- 4. You want to develop your own research project in Spain for the next 5 years as a PI.
- 5. <u>Applications</u> online before January 16, 2108 (Spanish language NOT required).

STEP TWO (GETTING ACCEPTANCE FROM A SPANISH RESEARCH INSTITUTION)

Those with a RyC position in step one need to apply for acceptance by their chosen Spanish research institution by late 2018. We consider applications at the <u>Complutense University</u> (UCM) (<u>Lymphocyte Immunobiology</u> research group) under the following conditions:

- 6. Your two-year postdoc must **not** have been at the Complutense University.
- 7. Interest in teaching and mentoring students is required for step three (English only is OK).
- 8. We offer space, scientific independence and an excellent tenure track to become Associate Professor by 2024 (step three). Salary 33.720 €/year + 40.000 € start-up grant.
- 9. We favor projects related or complementary to our scientific interests (Figure).
- 10.RyC grantees are expected to apply for additional <u>national</u> or <u>international</u> grants. An <u>ERC</u> grant at any time earns fast track to a permanent position, see point 13.
- 11. Signed <u>acceptance</u> expected by late September 2018 (conditional acceptance is OK). Incorporation is expected by January 2019 (exceptions apply: maternity/paternity/sick leave, previous commitments).

STEP THREE (GETTING A PERMANENT POSITION AT THE COMPLUTENSE UNIVERSITY)

- 12.RyC grantees may apply any time for external evaluation of their merits at <u>Aneca</u> (research, teaching and mentoring) and after 4,5 years in UCM (<u>I3 program</u>: papers/grants as PI).
- 13.If successful, they are offered a permanent position for their highest Aneca accreditation (Associate or Full Professor). An ERC grant earns fast track to a permanent position. The UCM gets a 100.000 € bonus for each tenured RyC (in addition to 33.720 €/year x 5 years).
- 14.All nine RyC in our Dept. were successful to date (a): 2005**Reche PA, 2006**Fernández-Malavé E, 2008**Lafuente EM, 2011**Martínez-Quiles N, 2011**Roda-Navarro P, 2014 Goicoechea de Jorge E, 2015 Cubero FJ, 2016 Redondo-Muñoz J, 2017 Iborra S. a- Call/starting year, tenure track (Associate Professor **civil servant/PTU, ^I3) and name.
