- To train specialists in various areas of information technology and its applications to teaching-learning English.
- To train professionals in intercultural communications and translation.

Graduates in English Philology, English Studies, Translation and Interpretation. Certified Level of English C1 (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). Consideration will also be given to: academic record (40 points), curriculum vitae (30 points), knowledge of languages certified by official entities (10 points) and other merits (20 points).

- Media professional.


Structure

The Master's Degree is composed of modules and subjects:

- Core Training Module: 12 compulsory ECTS
- Specific Training Module: 36 elective ECTS
- Final Project Module:
 12 compulsory ECTS

Students must complete 60 ECTS: 2 compulsory subjects, 6 electives and the Final Year Project.

There is no definition by itineraries, therefore students may obtain their elective credits by choosing among the elective subjects offered, according to their training needs and future professional orientation.
