Some master's thesis I

- Spatiotemporal geostatistical model of crime in El Salvador: Structural and predictive analysis
- Multistage stochastic optimization model of hydrothermal system of El Salvador
- Analysis of macroeconomic variables in El Salvador: Period 1995 to the second quarter of 2009
- Estimating the susceptibility to landslides in the metropolitan area of San Salvador using artificial neural networks

Some master's thesis II

- Modeling and forecasting of electricity demand in the medium term in El Salvador
- Economic factors affecting private investment in El Salvador
- Comparison between discriminant analysis and logistic regression in the classification of a colony of crabs
- Development of synthetic indicators of economic activity in El Salvador

- 5 promotions for the Master in Statistics
- 1 PhD in the UCM
- Stays in Spain for students
- Degree in Statistics
- Improvement in the Degree in Mathematics
- Some students take responsibility for high positions at Government and University

Some projects I

- Humanitarian logistics
- Optimization model for inventory management in anti-retroviral medicine in Zambezia
- The estimated revenue of the tax authority (Bayesian regression)
- A model to analyze the problem of queues in a health center for people living with HIV.
- A regression model to explain the factors influencing the employment index in Mozambique

Some projects II

- Analysis of health status of tilapia through physical-chemical parameters that contribute to the development of these species in the Company Aquaquel-Quelimane by multivariate techniques
- Factors associated with non-retention of participants in the prospective study of HIV in Mozambique
- Prediction Customs revenues in Mozambique
- Factors influencing the weight of newborns
