

Leadership for internationalization: implications and opportunities

English-Medium Instruction (EMI) and student/staff mobility have emerged as tools for the internationalization of higher education, as a necessary adaptation to the forces of globalization. This seminar will present internationalization in a broader perspective, whereby the change in medium of instruction and student demographics have become a means to initiate reform in the delivery and services of higher education, in order to enhance quality. The question of language and student diversity leads university leadership to consider the pedagogical, linguistic and cultural implications of this new context, as well as rethink the professional development of teaching staff.

How can we prepare our institutions and our students to be globally engaged and therefore prepared for life and work in a globalized world? What strategic considerations must university leadership take into consideration in order to ensure the highest quality? How can higher education institutions initiate such change sustainably?

This seminar will engage leadership in reflecting on these questions.
