Manuel got his Ph.D. in Economics and MA in Political Economy at Boston University with the field of specialization of Health Economics and Industrial Organization. He has been Academic Secretary and Director of the Spanish Encounter of the Drug Industry that takes place annually at the Universidad Internacional Menéndez Pelayo in Santander, Spain. Manuel acts also as Lecturer of Health Economics at the Instituto de Empresa in Madrid, in the Master of Biotechnology Management, and Hibernia College in Dublin. He has published in peer reviewed economic journals as Health Economics, Health Policy, Research Policy, or European Journal of Health Economics among others, and is a member of the Boards of Directors of the Spanish Health Economics Association.
