Duration: 40 hours (20 hours per week)
Modality: Face-to-face

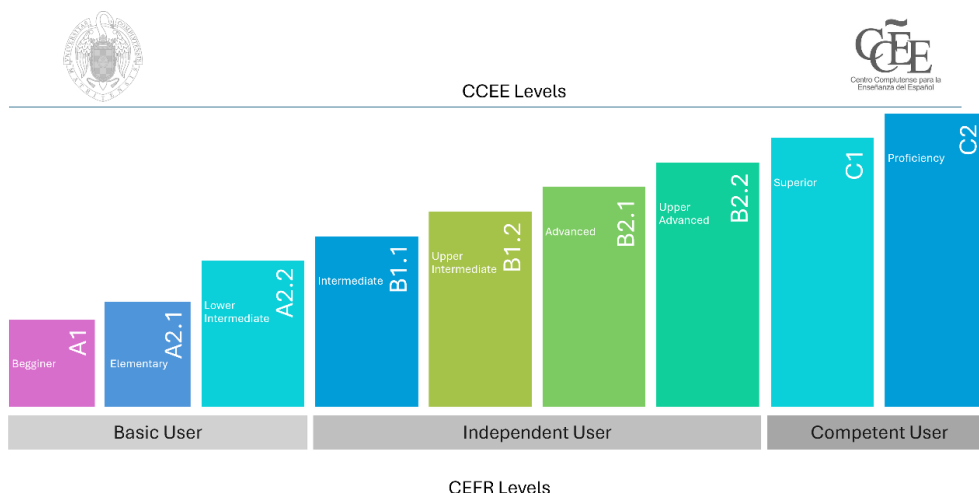


TEACHING STAFF

All teachers are university graduates and specialists in teaching Spanish as a foreign language.

DESCRIPTION

The **July Spanish Course** is designed for students who wish to learn or improve their Spanish at any level of the **Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)**: A1 – Beginner, A2 – Elementary, B1 – Intermediate, B2 – Upper Intermediate, C1 – Advanced, C2 – Proficient.



OBJECTIVE

The aim of the course is to enhance students' knowledge of Spanish language and culture across different areas and to develop greater fluency within a short period of time.

The course consists of four hours of Spanish language instruction per day, from Monday to Friday.

SPANISH COURSE CONTENT

Course content may vary depending on students' language level. The main subjects covered include:

- Grammar (according to level).
- Language Practice (according to level).
- Written Comprehension and Expression (according to level)
- Oral Comprehension and Expression (according to level).

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Students may also choose to complement their language training with the following cultural subjects:

- **Spanish Culture** (from July 2 to July 15) - Profª: Julia Corral 

PLACEMENT TEST

The placement test is taken online approximately 15 days before the start of the course to assign each student to the appropriate level.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Grammar

- Understands texts adapted to the course level, identifying the main information and relevant details.
- Produces brief or extended written texts, depending on the level, with coherence, cohesion, and communicative appropriateness.
- Uses the vocabulary and structures worked on in the writing activities.

Language Practice

- Understands and uses the grammatical structures studied during the course according to their level.
- Applies linguistic contents in oral and written communicative tasks.
- Shows progress in the accuracy and correctness of Spanish usage.

Written Comprehension and Expression

- Understands texts adapted to the course level, identifying the main information and relevant details.
- Produces brief or extended written texts, depending on the level, with coherence, cohesion, and communicative appropriateness.
- Uses the vocabulary and structures worked on in the writing activities.

Oral Comprehension and Expression

- Understands oral messages and conversations appropriate to their level of competence.
- Participates in communicative exchanges using strategies to express opinions, describe, narrate, or interact according to their level.
- Gradually improves fluency, pronunciation, and oral interaction.

The Certificate of Completion is awarded upon successfully finishing the course. You must pass the exams and the requirements for regular class attendance.
