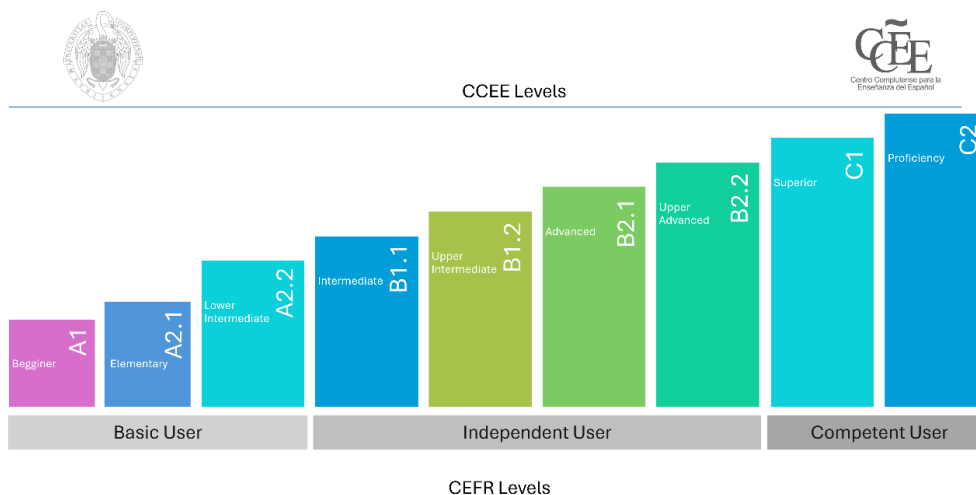


### TEACHING STAFF

### DESCRIPTION

The **July Spanish Course** is designed for students who wish to learn or improve their Spanish at any level of the **Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)**: A1 – Beginner, A2 – Elementary, B1 – Intermediate, B2 – Upper Intermediate, C1 – Advanced, C2 – Proficient.



### OBJECTIVE

Develop the students' grammatical competence so that they can understand and produce oral and written messages in Spanish with correctness, accuracy, and appropriateness to the communicative context suitable for the enrolled level.

### SPANISH COURSE CONTENT


Course content may vary depending on students' language level. The main subjects covered include:

- Grammar (according to level).
- Language Practice (according to level).
- Written Comprehension and Expression (according to level)
- Oral Comprehension and Expression (according to level).

### PLACEMENT TEST

The placement test is taken online approximately 15 days before the start of the course to assign each student to the appropriate level.

### EVALUATION CRITERIA

#### Grammar

- Understands and uses the grammatical structures corresponding to their level of competence.
- Applies grammatical content in oral and written communicative situations.
- Demonstrates progressive improvement in linguistic accuracy and correctness.
- Uses self-correction strategies to improve their outputs.

#### Language Practice

- Appropriately uses the linguistic resources covered in the course in real or simulated communicative contexts.
- Functionally integrates grammatical structures, vocabulary, and communicative functions appropriate to their level.
- Operates effectively in various oral and written communication situations suitable to their level of competence.
- Actively participates in interaction activities, showing the ability to understand and respond appropriately.
- Applies communicative strategies to overcome difficulties in expression or comprehension.
- Produces messages that are understandable and appropriate to the communicative situation, although non-systematic errors may occur.

#### Written Comprehension and Expression

- Understands written texts appropriate to their level, identifying general and specific information.
- Interprets the communicative intention and the main elements of different types of texts.
- Produces written texts appropriate to the proposed task, with a level of coherence, cohesion, and correctness according to their level.
- Uses the vocabulary and structures worked on during the course in their written productions.
