TEACHING STAFF

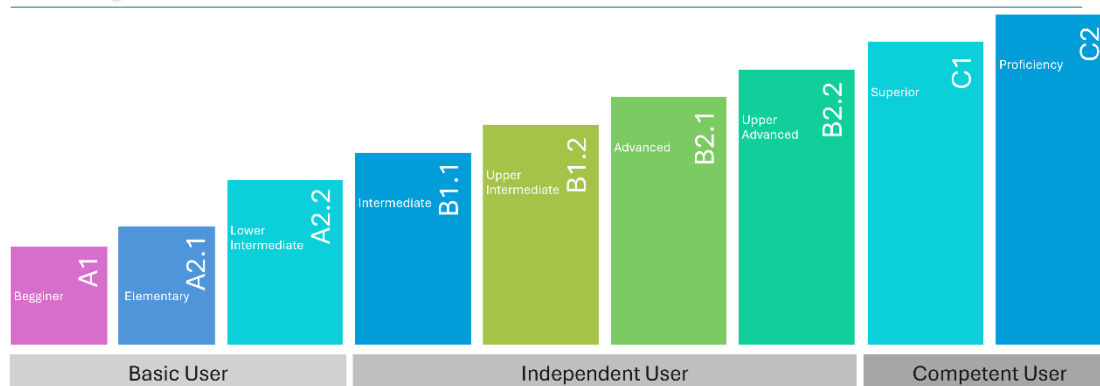
All teachers are university graduates and specialists in teaching Spanish as a foreign language.

DESCRIPTION

The **July Spanish Course** is designed for students who wish to learn or improve their Spanish at any level of the **Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)**: A1 – Beginner, A2 – Elementary, B1 – Intermediate, B2 – Upper Intermediate, C1 – Advanced, C2 – Proficient.

OBJECTIVE

The aim of the course is to enhance students' knowledge of Spanish language and culture across different areas and to develop greater fluency within a short period of time.

The course consists of four hours of Spanish language instruction per day, from Monday to Friday.

SPANISH COURSE CONTENT

Course content may vary depending on students' language level. The main subjects covered include:



- Grammar (according to level).
- Language Practice (according to level).

Students may also choose to complement their language training with the following cultural subjects:

PLACEMENT TEST

The placement test is taken online approximately 15 days before the start of the course to assign each student to the appropriate level.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Grammar

- Recognizes and understands the grammatical structures corresponding to their level of competence.
- Correctly uses the forms and grammatical structures worked on in oral and written activities.
- Applies the morphosyntactic rules of Spanish with a degree of accuracy appropriate to their level.
- Identifies and corrects common grammatical errors in their own and others' productions.

Language Practice

- Uses the studied linguistic resources to manage in communicative situations appropriate to their level.
- Applies the vocabulary and linguistic structures suitable for the context and communicative intention.
- Actively participates in activities of interaction and linguistic mediation.
- Demonstrates progressive autonomy in the use of learning and communication strategies.

Written Comprehension and Expression

- Understands written texts appropriate to their level, identifying general and specific information.
- Interprets the meaning of texts taking into account the context and communicative intent.
- Produces written texts that are coherent, cohesive, and appropriate to the assigned task.
- Uses grammar, vocabulary, and spelling resources suitable for their level of proficiency.
- Reviews and improves their written work using self-correction strategies.

Oral Comprehension and Expression

- Understands oral messages related to communicative situations appropriate to their level.
- Identifies relevant information, main ideas, and specific details in different types of listening activities.
- Expresses themselves orally with clarity, using structures and vocabulary suitable for their level.
- Participates in conversations and communicative exchanges, respecting speaking turns and basic interaction norms.
