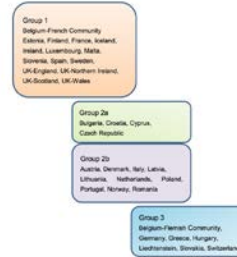

The European Credit System for Vocational Education and Training ECVET

- European Credit System for Vocational Education and Training
- A system for the transfer, validation and accumulation of the learning outcomes achieved by an individual with a view to acquiring a qualification
- European tool to improve attractiveness of lifelong learning and support mobility across Europe

ECVET Principals

There are 2 sets of Principals at the heart of ECVET

- The use of Learning Outcomes
- The use of agreed assessment, validation and recognition procedures

These Principals assist with enabling learning to be recognized no matter where it is achieved

What ECVET is Not

- It is not a Qualification
- It is not an Awarding Body
- It is not Compulsory
- It does not need to be implemented all in the one go

ECVET terminology

LEARNING OUTCOMES	UNITS
Statements of what a learners knows, understands and is able to do on completion of a learning process	Components of qualifications; a coherent set of knowledge, skills and competences that is able to be assessed and validated
ECVET POINTS	CREDIT
Numerical representation of the overall weight of learning outcomes and the relative weight of units in relation to a qualification	For units which have been assessed and which can be accumulated towards a qualification or transferred to other learning programmes or qualifications

Key concepts and processes

The objective of ECVET is to facilitate the transfer, recognition and accumulation of assessed learning outcomes of individuals who are aiming to achieve a qualification.

This is possible because each unit is documented and the learning outcomes it contains can be assessed and validated.

Hence learners can:

- Progressively accumulate learning outcomes in view of achieving a qualification;
- Obtain recognition for their learning outcomes achieved in other contexts without new assessment (i.e. units can be transferred).

ECVET and non-formal and informal learning

ECVET facilitates the development of flexible and individualized pathways and also the recognition of those learning outcomes which are acquired through non-formal and informal learning.

For applying ECVET at this way, the competent institution which is empowered to award qualifications or units or to give credit should establish procedures and mechanisms for the identification, validation and recognition of these learning outcomes through the award of the corresponding units and the associated ECVET points.

ECVET and non-formal and informal learning

The validation process for non-formal and informal learning in view of achieving a qualification follows these phases:

1. Identification of knowledge, skills and competences developed during personal activities, while living in a community or working, etc.
2. Documentation of these learning outcomes through the collection of evidence such as descriptions of previous working activities, etc.
3. Assessment of these learning outcomes against standards, referential or list of expected learning outcomes.
4. Award of a qualification or part of a qualification

ECVET Competent Institutions

"Competent institution" means an institution which is responsible for designing and awarding qualifications or recognising units or other functions linked to ECVET, such as allocation of ECVET points to qualifications and units, assessment, validation and recognition of learning outcomes, under the rules and practices of participating countries.

The main challenge for the introduction of a common methodological framework like ECVET in the European VET environment is the broad range of bodies involved with the different functions of qualifications systems.

Depending on the system, the same function (e.g. design of qualifications and of units) may be the responsibility of different types of actors (e.g. national or regional ministries, social partners, VET providers).

ECVET and ERASMUS +

- Key Action 1 (Learning Mobility of individuals – Learners and Staff) Encourages the use of common transparency and recognition tools
- Key Action 2 (Cooperation for Innovation and Exchange of Good Practices) Encourages transparency and recognition and the use of related tools in training

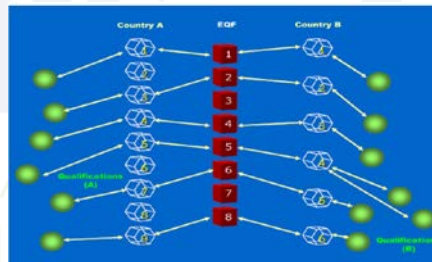


European Qualifications Framework

Reference framework that acts as a translation device comparing qualifications and levels across Europe

Eight levels, described in learning outcomes, from basic (level 1) to advanced (level 8)

Applies to all types of education
Promotes the validation of non-formal and informal learning



EUROPASS

European Skills, Competences and Occupations (ESCO)

Improve matching between job seekers and job vacancies by using common language between education and training and work Based on three 'pillars'

- Occupations
- Skills/competences
- Qualifications

Complements and builds on existing classifications, including UK's National Occupational Standards Only European multilingual classification linking skills and competences to occupations and is available free of charge

- ☺ In **constant evolution**, in part, thanks to the users.



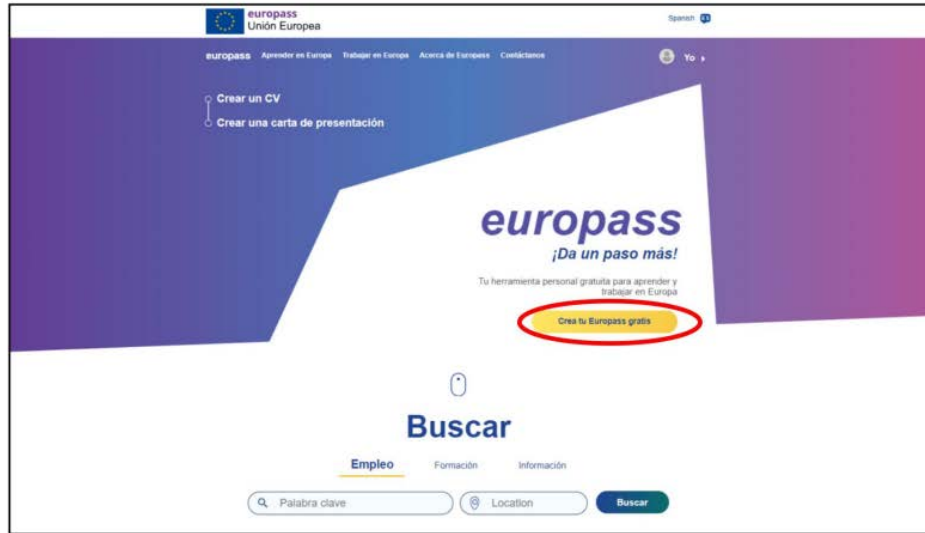

EUROPASS SUPPLEMENTS: FP TITLE

- ☉ Informative document issued and endorsed by educational institutions to promote recognition.
- ☉ It details what **FP studies, artistic and sports education** consist of.
- ☉ It is **NOT nominative** (possibility **Voluntary Annex**).
- ☉ It does NOT replace the title but complements it.
- ☉ To break language barriers: in **Spanish and English**.
- ☉ It contains information on: results, qualifications, credits, contents, type and level of the qualification, the institution that has issued the qualification and the national educational system in which it is framed.
- ☉ They should be **delivered by default** from the educational center when the studies are finished.
- ☉ Easily **downloadable**. [Access here](#)



EUROPASS SUPPLEMENT: CERTIFICATES OF PROFESSIONALISM

- ☉ Issued and endorsed by educational institutions.
- ☉ It explains to employers and educational institutions what a certain **professional certification consists of**.
- ☉ It is **NOT nominative** (possibility **Voluntary Annex**).
- ☉ It does NOT replace the title but complements it.
- ☉ So that language is not a barrier in another country: in **English and Spanish**.
- ☉ It contains information about: the purpose of the certification, the educational level, the learning results and the educational system where frame.
- ☉ They should be **delivered by default** from the training center at the end of the studies.
- ☉ Easily **downloadable**. [Access here](#)



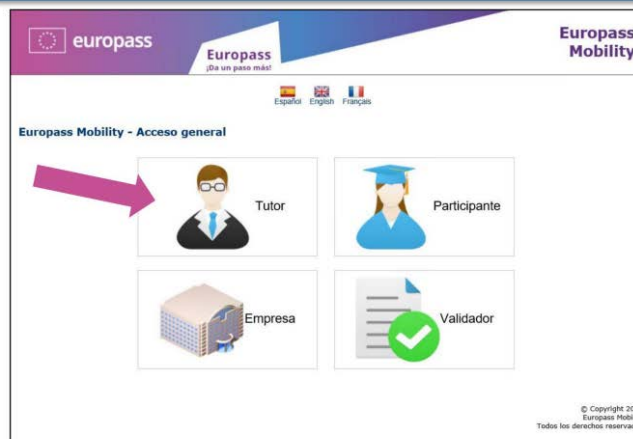


4 EUROPASS MOBILITY DOCUMENT (DME)

- It is the **great link between** and .
- It takes on special relevance in FP and School since it is the **only systematized tool for the recognition of participation in** transnational mobility projects of students, teachers and/or trainers.
- Three organizations participate in its expedition:** the one of origin (the Spanish one), the host one (the foreign one) and the CNE of SEPIE, the CC.AA or some Spanish universities as final validators.
- The DEM **recognizes the learning, knowledge and skills that the participant has acquired** in the European country to which they have traveled to study or gain work experience.
- The processing, issuance and download in Spain is done through a nationally owned **web application: Europass Mobility.**

EUROPASS MOBILITY - Processing

- Complete in **two languages: English and Spanish**. Two language versions are obtained from each DME .
- It can be processed before carrying out the mobility, although European members will NOT be able to validate their part until it is finished.
- Pay special attention to the **description of competencies** (section 5A).

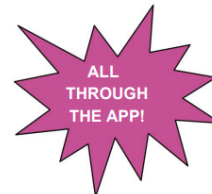
