This two-day workshop is part of the UCM Innovation Project (PIMCD) no. 124, entitled “Initial Teacher Education for CLIL: cross-curricular activities to develop multiple intelligences in the primary classroom”. Aims of the workshop:

This workshop will focus on the following objectives:

- 1) To bridge the gap between the university and primary classroom and become familiar with the bilingual school context through teacher experiences.
