Geological Survey of Finland (GTK) moved to Ótaniemi Chapel


Helsinki University of Technology (TKK) main building Dipoli building

The first mainframe computer, Univac 1108
Finnish IT Center for Science (CSC) was established
The Finns got acquainted with e-mail
Building of Funet network began

Otaniemi Science Park Ltd (Technopolis Ventures) established

The computer of the TKK was connected to the European academic and research network Earn Doors of "Incubator facilities" opened to tenants Innopoli 1 (Technopolis Innopoli Ltd)
Spinno Business Development Programs started

Strengthening co-op with university (Pre-Incubator) Innopoli 2

Technopolis Ltd acquired shares of Innopoli Ltd Otaniemi Marketing was established Professional level Incubator Services – Incubation Products

MIKES moved to Otaniemi 31,000 technology professionals in Otaniemi, over 600 companies






Otaniemi Innovation Model

- EVTEK University of Applied Sciences BA degrees in technology, business and design
- Laurea University of Applied Sciences BA degrees e.g. in social studies, health care and business








Otaniemi Innovation Model

The Raw Materials for Global Success

- 31 000 people in the community
- 15 000 students (about 1 200 foreign students)
- 252 professors
- 6 000 persons in research organizations
- 10 000 persons in technology companies
- Over 600 companies
- 500 new business ideas annually
- 60-80 new companies annually
- 200 patents filed annually








Why companies locate in Otaniemi?

Companies in Otaniemi (n=609)




