2. Scholarship Eligibility

The applicants are qualified for scholarship selection only after they get pre-admission in applying relevant majors. (For details, please see the guide of *Application for Admission for Undergraduate/ Master/PhD Program*)

2.1 Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens with a valid ordinary-type passport, and in good health.

2.2 Education background and age requirements:

Applicants studying for a bachelor's degree should be no more than 25 years old and have obtained high school diploma;

Applicants studying for a Master's degree should be no more than 35 years old and have obtained bachelor's degree;

Applicants studying for a PhD's degree should be no more than 40 years old and have obtained Master's degree.

2.3 Language proficiency

Applicants who apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship—Chinese University Program (Type B), or Shanghai Government Scholarship, Shanghai University New International Student Scholarship, the language proficiency requirements are as

follows:

1) If you are applying for Chinese-taught programs, HSK certificates requirements are higher than admission criteria:

- New HSK 5 above 180 for Art;
- New HSK 5 above 180 for Science or Engineering;
- New HSK 5 above 180 for Economics or Management;
- New HSK 5 above 240 for Humanities.

2) If you are applying for English-taught programs, English language requirements are higher than admission criteria. Either of the following requirements is enough:

- English is native or official language;
- IELTS (A) 6.5 or above; TOEFL IBT 90 or above; other internationally recognized English proficiency tests with scores of the same level and provide proof of certificates.

2.4 No other types of scholarship were granted at the time of application.

<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Supervisor Acceptance Letter (Download here) (Please download the template online, please note that the supervisor acceptance letter is not required for Master of School of Economics, School of Management, MBA center and SILC Business School and Doctoral of School of Economics. The colleges will assign tutors for eligible candidates soon after they are registered.. The college will assign tutors for eligible candidates soon after they are registered.) <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Study Plan or Research Proposal in China: Written in English or Chinese, no less than 800 words including research achievements so far, reasons of choosing SHU, study and research plan, future career plan, etc.
<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Others (Refer to Departmental standards): ①Publication of academic papers: Applicants who apply for a Ph.D. in the School of Management must have a background in management science or science and engineering and have published at least one academic paper in SCI or SSCI journals at the time of application. ②Applicants for art majors should provide at least two examples of artworks; ③Music majors applicants should provide audios and videos related to the major.

5. Scholarship Application Methods

5.1 Chinese Government Scholarship (CSC)

China Scholarship Council, entrusted by the Ministry of Education of China, is responsible for the enrollment and administration of Chinese Government Scholarship programs. Programs listed below are applicable to certain target prospective students. For more information, please refer to www.campuschina.org.

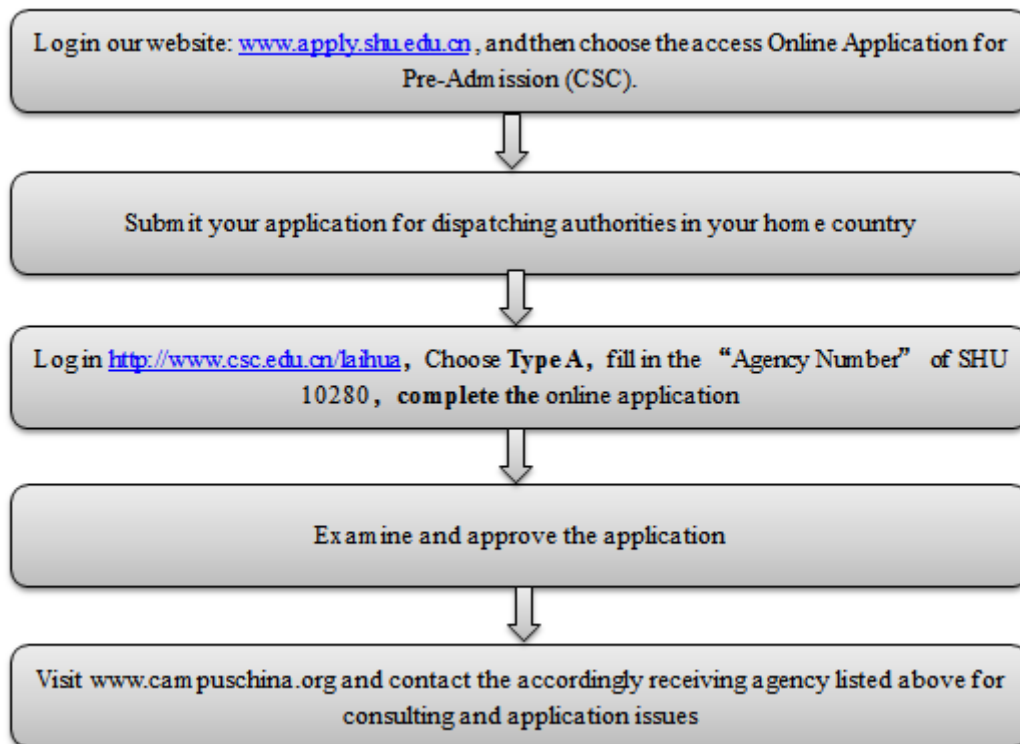
5.1.1 Chinese Government Scholarship (CSC)---Regular Programs (Type A)

Program Category Type A generally refers to scholarship programs responsible by authorities other than Chinese universities. Applicants of Type A programs are requested to fill in the 'Agency Number' of above mentioned agencies (e.g. Chinese Embassy in your country). Applications of Type A will be reviewed by these agencies.

5.1.1.1 When to apply:

Generally from the **beginning of January to the beginning of April**; for the exact dates, please consult the accordingly receiving agency listed above.

5.1.1.2 Application Procedures



Step 1: Log in University website (www.apply.shu.edu.cn) and complete application online. The qualified applicants will receive Pre-admission notice. More details please see the *Notice on Online Application for Pre-admission*. The National Oversea Student Fund Committee will check whether the scholarship applicants meet requirements. Applicants or application materials that do not meet the requirements shall not be accepted.

Step 2: The applicants submit application to the dispatching authorities of the home country and obtains the recommendation qualification.

Step 3: Applicants who have obtained the qualification of recommendation please log in to <http://www.csc.edu.cn/laihua> and select Oversea Study Categories Type A, fill in the **SHU Agency Number: 10280**, complete application online.

Step 4: The relevant agencies will check the applications and the application materials approved by the National Overseas Study Fund Committee will be forwarded to Shanghai University for admission. The National Overseas Study Fund Committee has the right to make appropriate adjustments to the schools, majors, types of subsidies and duration of scholarships chosen by applicants according to the requirements of different countries, accepting capacity of colleges and Universities, academic system requirements and qualifications of applicants, etc. The final results of admission will be determined by the university. Those with pre-admission notice of Shanghai University will be sent directly to Shanghai University for admission confirmation; Applicants admitted by Shanghai

University will be awarded the Chinese Government Scholarship upon the approval of the National Overseas Study Fund Committee. Each scholarship applicant can only receive one grant from the Chinese government scholarship program.

5.1.1.3 Application Results

1. The applicants may inquire about the admission results from the overseas student dispatching departments of their own countries. After review and approval of the National Overseas Study Fund Committee, the final admission results will be sent back to the program accepting agencies and then pass on to applicants. The applicants may inquire the results from the relevant scholarship acceptance agency.

2. The National Overseas Study Fund Committee will send «the list of admissions», «the admission notice» and «the visa application forms for overseas students» (JW201 Form) to the Chinese embassy (or Consulate-General) of the relevant countries by July 31. And then pass on to the International Student Dispatch Departments or the applicants.

5.1.2 Chinese Government Scholarship (CSC)--Chinese University Program (Type B)

Program Category Type B generally refers to scholarship programs responsible by Chinese universities under CGS-Chinese University Program

5.1.2.1 Accepting Agency: Shanghai University (Agency Number: 10280)

5.1.2.2 Applicable Programs

(1) Master's degree programs (except MTCSOL* and GLMBA program)

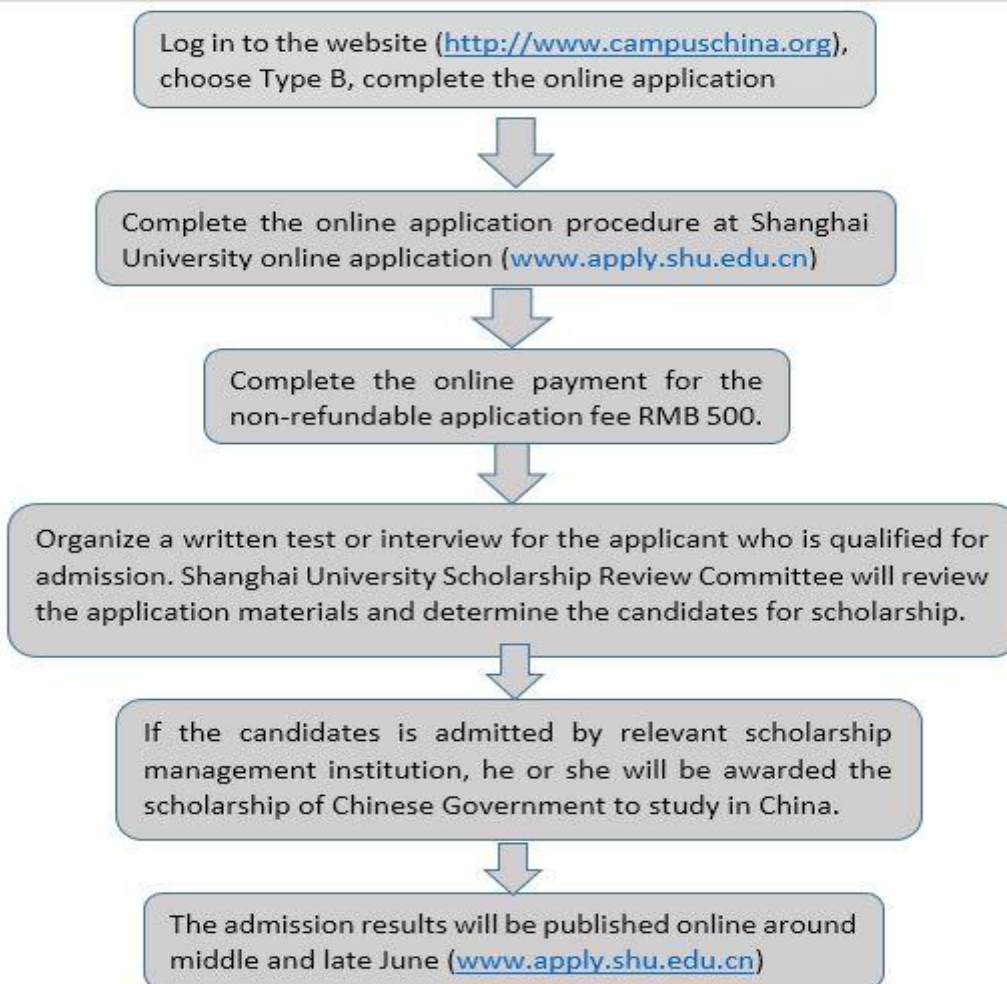
Note: MTCSOL refers to Master of Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages.

5.1.2.3 When to apply: 2019.1.1 to 2019.4.15

Note: The deadline of scholarship application in School of Economics is 2019.3.31.

5.1.2.5 Application Results:

If the candidates are qualified by the relevant scholarship management institutions, they will be awarded Chinese Government scholarship or Shanghai University Scholarship to study in China. The results of the proposed admission will be published online from mid-to-late June of 2019 (www.apply.shu.edu.cn). The final result of the scholarship admission is based on the paper admission materials.

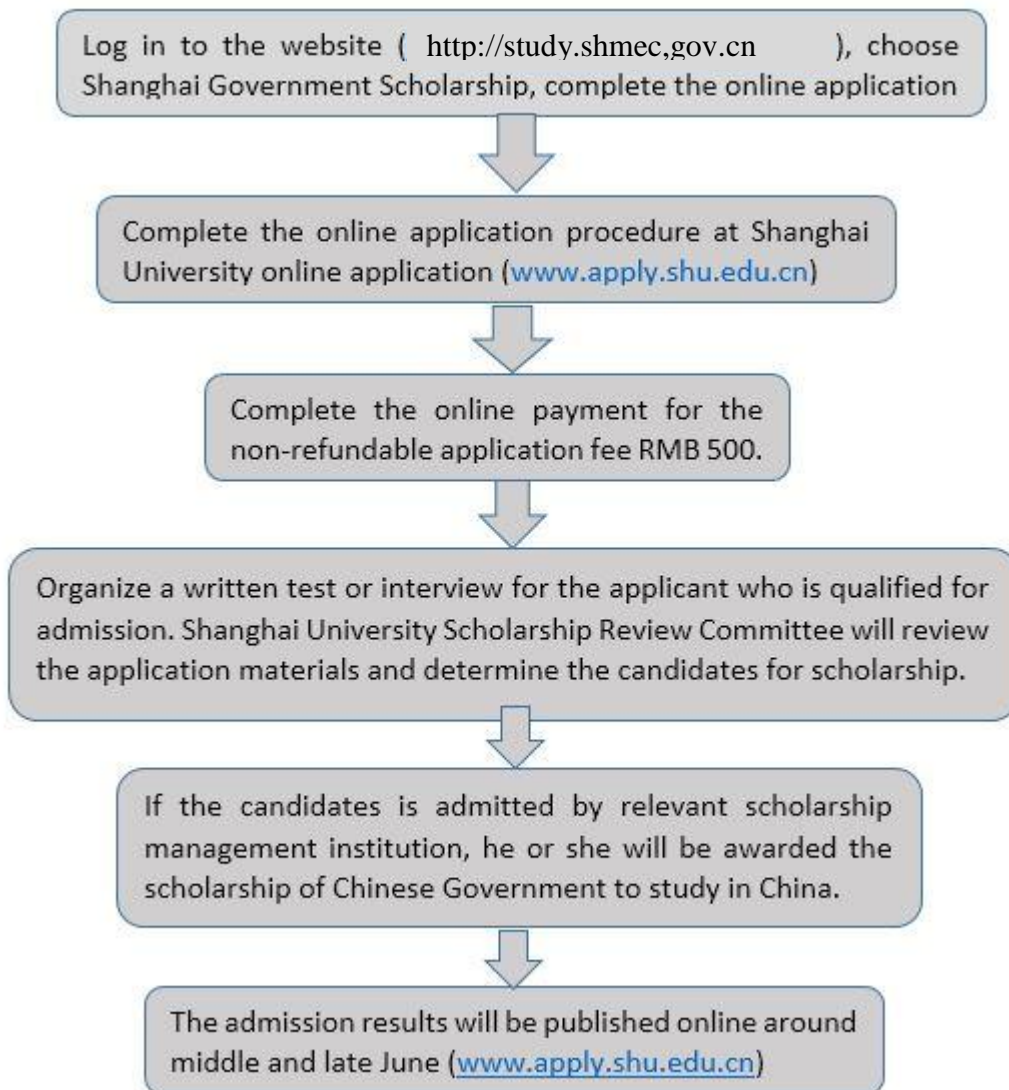
5.2 Shanghai Government Scholarships (SGS)

5.2.4 Selection Process

5.2.4.1 There are two ways of selecting for undergraduates programs:

Preferred Selection: Written examination (Chinese, Mathematics, Comprehensive Course)

Examination time: 2019.5.5

Examination location (choose 1 from 4): Shanghai University, Indonesia, Thailand, Vietnam.

Regular Selection: Online application+ experts review

5.2.4.2 Master's program will be selected through "Tutor admission & Experts interview"

5.3 Shanghai University New International Student Scholarship

Only for Master's and Doctoral programs. No need to apply separately. The scholarship recipients are selected from the applicants of Chinese Government Scholarship (CSC) --- Chinese University Program and Shanghai Government Scholarship.

5.4 Confucius Institute Scholarship

6. Others

6.1 Scholarship candidates should register on time. For late registration, please inform the contact person and submit the leave application, or your offer will be cancelled;

6.2 Scholarship candidates should bring all original documents for registration. Provision of any false/ misleading information or failure to provide the requested supporting documents will lead to disqualification of admission.

6.3 Scholarship students should apply for the annual review, which evaluates the study performance and daily performance for one academic year. Students who passed the annual review will be awarded with the scholarship next year.

6.4 Scholarship students cannot change the major, transfer to another university, or prolong the length of study in principle.

6.5 Those items shall be explained by the college of International Education, Shanghai University.
