Meeting tutors or supervisors

- Sequencing: to be set up between supervisors and PhD students on a semester basis.
- Students should meet their supervisors in regular tutorials throughout each semester period. In these sessions issues concerning the project, progress of research, possible publishing strategies, contents of students' potential publications, potential presentation of research results in Conferences, and -from the 5th semester onwards-, issues concerning the viva and preparation of students' CVs for future careers will be addressed.
- Students should hand in a report of accomplishments and completed tasks as well as an updated outline of their dissertation. Goals to be achieved in the following period should also be set in these meeting sessions.
- Students should be able to clearly identify the value of their work to date; they will highlight improvable aspects and set precise new targets.
- It is advisable for students to keep record of these sessions and main points in the discussion. These documents should be submitted to and signed by supervisors.
