Training plan

According to the legislation, the PhD Programme in English Linguistics UCM (PhD-Englin-UCM) provides as mandatory the following tasks:

Mandatory tasks

- ❖ Meetings with the thesis supervisor
- ❖ Presentation of the dissertation proposal
- ❖ Oral defense of the doctoral thesis
- ❖ Attendance to English Linguistics Advanced Research Seminar (mandatory starting from the 2019/2020 school year)
- ❖ Participation in Dissertation Proposal Workshop (mandatory starting from the 2019/2020 school year)

It also includes a series of training activities ([Article 4.1 RD 99/2011](#)) which represent a coherent training proposal in order to develop the necessary skills and achieve the relevant learning outcomes in a planned manner. The student will carry out these activities in accordance with the proposed schedule. The deadlines established in this schedule are considered ideal for the appropriate development of the studies, although they may be modified in agreement with the tutor or supervisor, especially in cases involving Part time students.

2. Two oral presentations in Scientific Conferences
3. Design and Delivery of the Dissertation Proposal Workshop
4. Organization of English Linguistics Conferences
5. Attendance to Scientific Conferences
