### **(Brief Course Description)**

#### **Cultures of Spain** (Spring semester)

The study of diverse cultures in contemporary Spain from a sociological, anthropological, literary and historical-political perspective. The course aims to offer key knowledge that will allow the student to understand contemporary Spanish identity. A synchronic vision will be developed, based on the 20th century and present post-modernity. Historical background will be provided when necessary. The course is complemented with cultural offerings in Madrid, Spain's capital. The course will develop the student's critical capacity by discussing in-depth topics and themes of Spanish cultural tradition. No prior knowledge of Spanish culture is necessary. A minimum of intermediate-high level of Spanish is required.
