Contemporary History of Spain: 1808 to Present (Spring semester)

Contemporary history of Spain from the Enlightenment to the present. Chronological high points include: French invasion, Fernando VII and Isabel II, Carlist Wars, liberal revolution, First Republic, Restoration of Bourbon monarchy, Alfonso XII, loss of last overseas territories of Colonial Empire (1898), monarchy of Alfonso XIII, Second Republic, Civil War and Franco's dictatorship, monarchy of Juan Carlos I, transition to democracy, and Spain under current administration.
