European Political Systems: The Spanish Model (Spring semester)

A historical and comparative study of the most representative political and administrative models of Europe in the 20th and 21st centuries. The course is divided into two parts: A specific analysis of the political systems in Germany, France, Italy, the United Kingdom, and the government of the European Union, and Spain as a unique political model that since 1931 has experienced the existence or coexistence of three different political systems: The Republic, dictatorship, and constitutional monarchy. Comparative analysis of political models between Europe and the United States of America.
