¡Welcome to Madrid!

To move freely using the city's public transport, you may use:

- **Single round-trip ticket** (one way or return) valid on the Metro, TFM, Metro Ligerio 1, and Metro Ligerio Oeste for **€1.50 or €2**.
- **10-ride "10 viajes T. F. M." Card** valid on the Metro, TFM, Metro Ligerio 1, Metro Ligerio Oeste, and city and intercity buses for **€6.10**.
- **Airport Supplement**, required for entry and exit to Airport Metro stations T1-T2-T3 or Airport T4 if traveling with a Single or 10-Ride ticket for **€3**.



Cards and single tickets can be obtained from automatic ticket machines inside metro, light rail ("metro ligero"), and some train stations, as well as at other authorized points of sale. Multi cards are not personal, and can be used by several people for the same trip. **VALIDATION BY TAPPING IS REQUIRED** upon entering and exiting the metro and upon boarding buses.

To get to the Faculty of Geography and History (Calle del Profesor Aranguren) you may:

- Walk from the **Ciudad Universitaria metro exit** (10 min). The exit is located in front of the Medicine faculty. To get to the Faculty of Geography and History, face the Medicine faculty and walk left along Avenida Complutense. Turn left at the roundabout and walk down Calle Profesor Aranguren.
- Take **EMT bus (blue) line G** from the Moncloa bus and metro interchange (metro lines 3 and 6, level 1), **towards Filosofía B**. The faculty will be the last stop: Filosofía B. You can also take this bus at the Ciudad Universitaria metro exit (line 6), towards Filosofía B.
- Take **EMT bus (blue) line F** from Cuatro Caminos, towards Filosofía B. The closest metro stops from the starting bus stop is **Cuatro Caminos (lines 6, 2, and 1)**. The faculty will be the last stop.
- Take **buses 133 and 83** from the Moncloa interchange (bus station on the street, **Calle Princesa** metro exit). The faculty will be at the Philosophy B stop, and you will need to cross the parking lot to reach the building entrance. To return to Moncloa from the building on these lines, you will need to go through the underground tunnel and take one of the G or F buses in the opposite direction (A-6 motorway).

Those wishing to arrive **from Sol**, in the city center, can take **metro line 3** toward Moncloa and take one of the aforementioned buses to the faculty entrance. **From Atocha**, the most reliable and fastest option is to take metro line 1 (toward Pinar de Chamartín) and change to line 3 at Sol (toward Moncloa).

Those traveling **from the Airport** (T4 and T1, 2, and 3) on their own can take **metro line 8** (toward Nuevos Ministerios) to reach the city center. This line from the Airport requires a €3 supplement. Taxis are available at the terminals.

Those arriving from the Residencia de Estudiantes may:

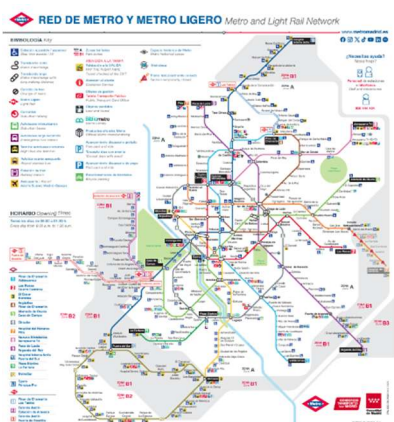
- Walk to the **República Argentina metro stop** (line 6) and take the metro to Moncloa or Ciudad Universitaria (towards Nuevos Ministerios/Guzmán el Bueno).
- Walk to the **Natural Sciences Museum**, take the **EMT (blue) bus 45** toward Ibáñez Ibero, change buses to the **EMT (blue) bus F**, and stop at Filosofía B.

THE CONGRESS WILL BE HELD IN THE ASSEMBLY HALL (“Salón de Actos”), FLOOR 2. THERE IS AN ELEVATOR AND STAIRS. ACCESS CAN BE MADE THROUGH THE DOOR ON THE GROUND FLOOR (floor 0, opposite the parking lot) OR THE DOOR ON FLOOR 1 (opposite the bus stop for lines G and F).

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Most tourist areas and the city center are within Zone A of the metro, so tickets outside this zone will require another type of transport card.
- Metro lines 6, 3, 1, and 2 during rush hour (7:30-9:30 a.m. and 2-4 p.m.) can be very crowded, especially for students near the university. Similarly, the Sol, Callao, and Gran Vía areas are often crowded, so be careful with your belongings.
- It is possible to use the short-distance train (**Renfe**) to get to Atocha or Sol. However, train tickets are NOT included in the 10-trip cards and should be paid separately.
- The city center of Madrid is easily walkable. We recommend that if you plan to get around Sol, Atocha, Paseo del Prado, and nearby neighborhoods, take the opportunity to walk and enjoy the architecture and lifestyle.
- Chueca, Lavapiés, and Antón Martín are some ideal areas for dining. Argüelles and Moncloa are close to the faculty, offering places to grab a bite, have lunch or have some drinks. Other faculties, such as the Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Philosophy and Literature, are also close to the building. Our faculty cafeteria is on the ground floor (level 0).
