

of the evaluation and the defense of the dissertation will be recognized by both institutions.

The Examination Committee shall be appointed by the home university and previously approved by the partner university. It will consist of university professors or researchers from both countries from a minimum of four up to eight members, supervisors included.

Article 8

The Thesis will be written in Italian. A summary will be written in Spanish.

Article 9

After the successful completion of the procedure and on the basis of the report of the examination committee, each institution will award its own doctoral degree certificate (double diploma).

It will be indicated on both degree certificates, that it is the result of an international joint supervision of doctoral thesis.

The University of Florence will award the qualification of
Dottore di Ricerca in Filosofia – Curriculum in Etica, Politica e Religioni
and

The Complutense University of Madrid will award the qualification of
Doctor por la Universidad Complutense

Article 10

This Agreement shall enter into force after it has been signed by the authorized representatives of both institutions. This agreement is written up in n. 4 originals having legal value.

By signing this agreement the PhD Student and the supervisors pledge to act in accordance with the doctoral regulations in force in each institution. In the event of disputes, it shall be decided by mutual consent which regulations shall apply.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Article 6

The PhD Student will conduct doctoral research under the supervision and responsibility of the following Professors:

At the University of Florence (UNIFI):

Prof. Adriano Fabris

Dipartimento di Civiltà e Forme del Sapere

Università degli Studi di PISA

Dottorato di Ricerca in Filosofia

At UCM:

Prof. José Luis Cañas Fernández

Department: Philosophy and Society

School: Philosophy

These professors agree to be jointly responsible for the supervision of the doctoral Thesis.

Article 7

The PhD student will present his doctoral thesis, according to the rules established by the two signatory Universities.

Following the 3 years PhD programme, the thesis will be evaluated by two external referees, as required by the Italian law in force, in order to be admitted to the thesis defense. Just in case of a positive evaluation of the thesis, the two institutions will decide upon the opening of the doctoral examination procedures and carry out the appraisal and display of the thesis according to their respective regulations. The defense of the thesis will be concluded by a single final exam at the University of Florence. The result



evaluation of the thesis by two external referees an extension of 6 months is permitted (See art. 7).

The duration of the research period for the dissertation may be not less than two years from the approval of the joint supervision by the Doctoral Committees.

Work for the preparation of the dissertation will be carried out at both institutions. The period of stay at the Complutense University of Madrid should be not less than six months.

Article 2

Tuition fees has to be paid at the University of Florence, as home institution. Derogating from the joint agreement between the Italian and Spanish Rectors, the Complutense University of Madrid foresees the payment of the tuition fees from the doctoral candidate, who accepts to pay them.

Article 3

According to the legislation of both Universities, Bryan Jesús Irias Alfaro is responsible for securing himself an adequate health insurance for the entire period of his enrolment as a doctoral student. A securing insurance, in case of accident and damage to third parties – after the enrolment – is covered by the University of Florence and by Bryan Jesús Irias Alfaro himself, who shall pay an insurance premium (amounting as now at 6.50 Euros).

Article 4

The travel and housing costs of examination committee members will be paid by the University of Florence, as home institution.

Article 5

The doctoral Student will benefit from the facilities of each University, provided the tutelage fees have been paid.

JOINT DOCTORATE PROGRAMME AGREEMENT

The University of Florence, whose headquarters are at Piazza S. Marco 4, fiscal code n. 01279680480, represented by its Rector, Prof. Luigi Dei, born in Florence on the 10th of June 1956

and

the Complutense University of Madrid, whose headquarters are at Avenida de Séneca, 2, Madrid - 28040 España, represented by its Rector, Prof. Joaquín Goyache Goñi, hereinafter jointly referred to as “institutions”

DECLARE

Both Institutions share the common aim of promoting and developing scientific cooperation through the joint supervision of doctoral thesis, encouraging the mobility of doctoral candidates of the respective institutions.

Based on this common interest, both Parties

AGREE

To sign this specific agreement formalizing the co-supervision of the PHD student Mr. Bryan Jesús Irias Alfaro thesis, entitled “Teoría della vita umana tra storicità e metafisica: Julián Marías in dialogo con i maestri della Escuela de Madrid”/ “Teoría de la vida humana entre historicidad y metafisica: Julián Marías en diálogo con los maestros de la Escuela de Madrid”, according to the following academic requirements and administrative guidelines.

ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES

Article 1

The estimated duration for the preparation of the dissertation is set at three years.

The Italian Legislation in force does not admit any extension of the research work.

Therefore, it shall be concluded compulsorily in three years. Just in case of a negative
