BASIC GUIDE

1 WHAT IS A PHD?

A PhD is a postgraduate degree awarded to students who carry out an original research, which is called a doctoral dissertation (or thesis).

A PhD thesis must be carried out under the supervision of at least one university professor. However, students can apply for the joint supervision of their work to add value to it. Students may also apply for an international PhD mention to enhance the international dimension of their thesis. Students may opt to write the thesis in a “full-length format” or a “papers-style format”.

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During your time as a PhD student, you should become familiar with the UCM Doctoral School (Escuela de Doctorado), which is in charge of regulating all the PhD programmes within the UCM, including our PhD Programme in English Linguistics.

Since our programme belongs to the UCM, this institution may sometimes ask you to complete some paperwork, which must be done in Spanish (level B). Our programme aims to offer the best possible support to our students. For this reason, we will also ask you to do some extra work oriented to improving your PhD dissertation. In this case, however, English will be the language of communication.

We understand this duality may be complex, and that is why all students, precisely first-year students and international students, are strongly advised to visit our webpage, as well as to attend our welcome session, held at the beginning of the year, where you will have the opportunity to ask any questions you may have.

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3 TRAINING PLAN

Students who enrol in our programme can do so either fulltime (4 years) or part-time (7 years).

During this time, you are expected to, at least, meet with your supervisor and/or supervisors regularly, attend any training activity organised by the programme, and complete your research proposal and dissertation.
