

**Rector's Resolution dated 22 September 2021 of the Complutense University of Madrid, approving the provisional list of those admitted and excluded from the call for the post with reference code PAII43/21-12BIS/2021-01 for research staff in charge of research projects or finalist grants, approved by Rector's Resolution of 7 September 2021.**

In accordance with the terms and conditions of the call for the selective tests to fill 1 post of research personnel in charge of research projects or finalist grants approved by Resolution 7 September 2021 within the framework of the Regulatory Provision of the Selection Process for this staff, approved by the Governing Council of this University, this Rectorate, in use of the powers vested in it,

### **HAS DECIDED**

**First.-** To approve the provisional list of candidates admitted and excluded for the post that has been advertised, which is attached as an Annex to this Resolution.

**Second.-** The above-mentioned documentation is available on the website of the Complutense University of Madrid <http://www.ucm.es/>.

**Third.-** Applicants have a period of 3 working days from the day following the publication of this Resolution to rectify the defects that have led to their express exclusion or non-inclusion in the list of candidates in the selection process.

**Fourth.-** The correction shall be formalised through the telematic application enabled for this purpose on the website of the Research Service, attaching, where appropriate, the necessary documentation. The online application will be open **from 23 to 27 September 2021**.

The applicant will sign the document automatically generated by the telematic application and will register it, preferably, through the Electronic Registry of the Complutense University of Madrid, **until 27 September 2021**.

Should it not be possible to register it electronically, the participants, once they have completed the correction by electronic means, as described above, must print the correction document, and present it in person at the UCM registry assistance offices (<https://www.ucm.es/registro-general>) by requesting an appointment through the link: <https://citaprevia.ucm.es>. The applicant will then send a scanned copy of the application with the signature and visible registration stamp, or receipt of registration, to the following e-mail address: **pinves.seleccion@ucm.es**

Likewise, you may also register using the other methods established in article 16.4 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on the Common Administrative Procedure for Public Administrations. Postal services abroad, whether public or private, are not valid registers, in accordance with article 16.4 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October. Applications submitted in a register other than an entry register will not be accepted.

Any document submitted on paper must undergo a quarantine period as a consequence of the application of preventive measures and public health recommendations in the Community of Madrid, related to COVID-19.
