- Its origin dates back to the late 13th Century.







European Health Insurance Card

EUROPEAN HEALTH INSURANCE CARD

- This card is compulsory for Erasmus students (except for ICM KA107 students, who must take out a Private Health Insurance for the whole duration of their stay).
- The Spanish National Health System:
 - □ Free of charge for Erasmus Students (Private Health Insurance holders to consult HI company about the health centers and doctors assigned for medical assistance).
 - □ Healthcare Centres (family medicine, paediatrics and nursing)
 - Hospitals are all over the country but you'll need to be referred by a doctor for any hospital treatment.
 - Medicines prescribed by doctors must be purchased in pharmacies and will have the same discounts as Spanish residents.
- **Emergency** telephone: **112** (no area code needed)




