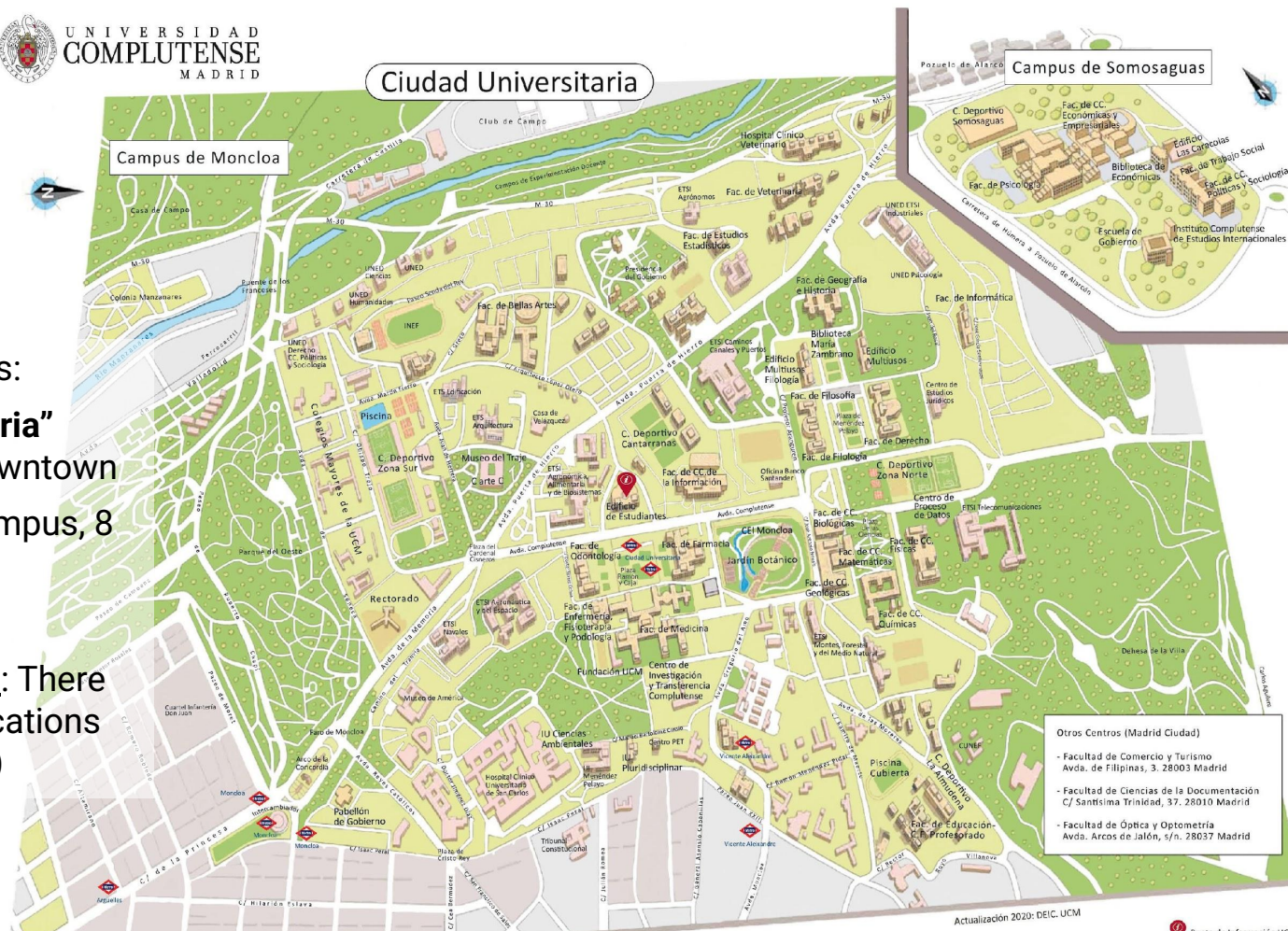

- ☐ This card is compulsory for Erasmus students (**except for ICM KA107 students**, who must be provided with a Private Health Insurance for the whole duration of their stay).
- ☐ The **Spanish National Health System**:
  - ☐ **Free of charge** for Erasmus Students (**Private Health Insurance holders to consult HI company about the health centers and doctors assigned for medical assistance**).
  - ☐ **Healthcare Centres** (family medicine, paediatrics and nursing)
  - ☐ **Hospitals** are all over the country but you'll need to be referred by a doctor for any hospital treatment.
  - ☐ **Medicines** prescribed by doctors must be purchased in pharmacies and will have the same discounts as Spanish residents.
- ☐ **Emergency** telephone: **112** (no area code needed)

### Central Register of Foreign Nationals

As a citizen of an EU member state or a state party to the European Economic Area (EEA) Agreement, you have the right to live in Spain. However, **if your stay will be longer than 3 months**, you must register with the **Registro Central de Extranjeros**. This is a simple administrative procedure.

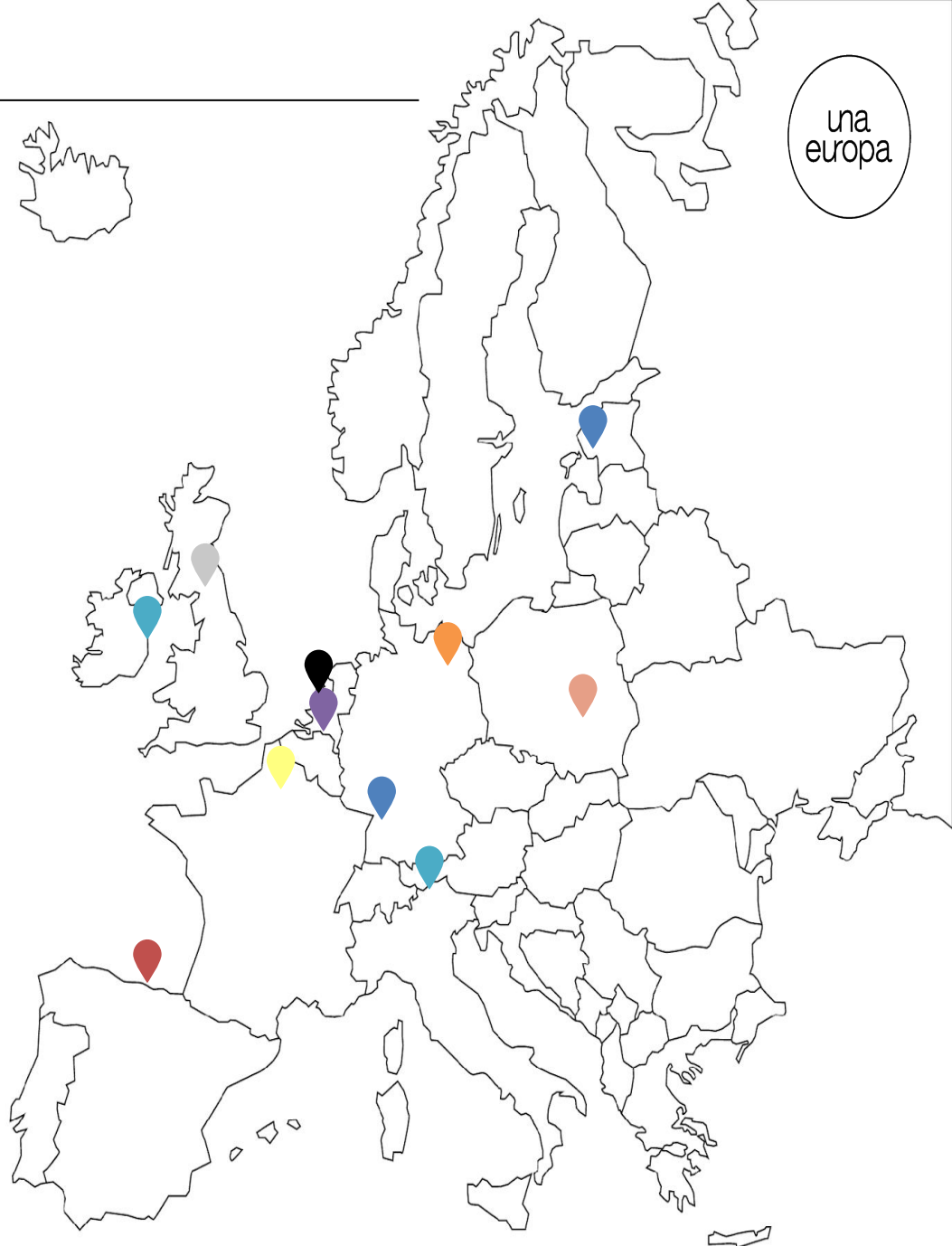

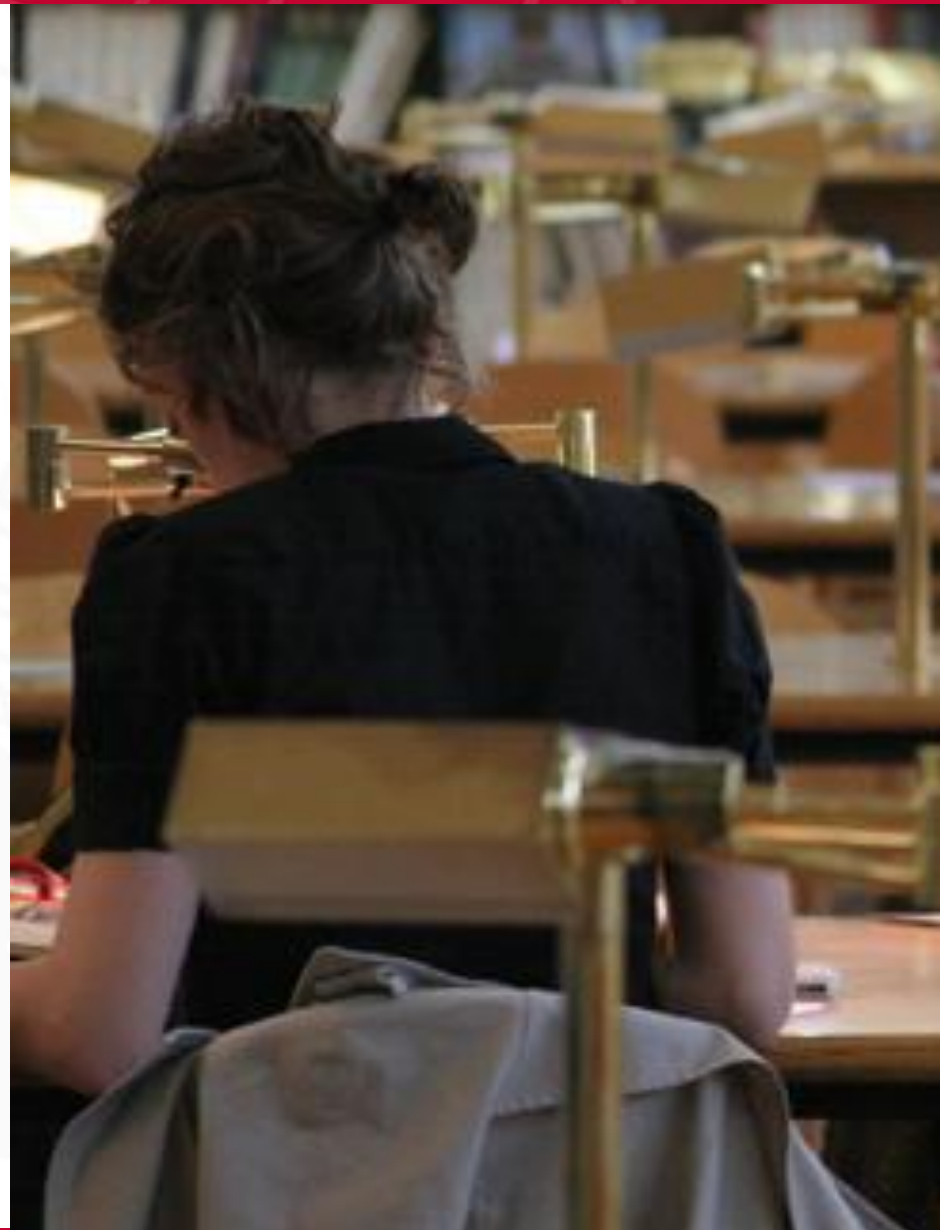
