



# **European Health Insurance Card**

- This card is compulsory for Erasmus students (<u>except for</u> <u>ICM KA107 students</u>, who must be provided with a Private Health Insurance for the whole duration of their stay).
- □ The Spanish National Health System:
  - Free of charge for Erasmus Students (Private Health Insurance holders to consult HI company about the health centers and doctors assigned for medical assistance).
  - Healthcare Centres (family medicine, paediatrics and nursing)
  - Hospitals are all over the country but you'll need to be referred by a doctor for any hospital treatment.
  - Medicines prescribed by doctors must be purchased in pharmacies and will have the same discounts as Spanish residents.

# **EU STUDENTS**

Entry and stay in Spain as an European student: information about legal requirements

## **Central Register of Foreign Nationals**

As a citizen of an EU member state or a state party to the European Economic Area (EEA) Agreement, you have the right to live in Spain. However, **if your stay will be longer than 3 months**, you must register with the **Registro Central de Extranjeros**. This is a simple administrative procedure.

You can register in person at:

- Oficinas de Extranjería de Madrid
- <u>Comisarías de Policía</u> de Madrid

We recommend contacting the relevant office (Immigration Office or Police Station) before your visit to confirm the necessary documents.





Entry and stay in Spain as an Non-European student:

VISA: stays for study programmes longer that 90 days will need a visa.

Where: <u>Spanish diplomatic mission or consular office</u> in whose demarcation the foreigner resides. Oficina de Extranjería (Madrid).




