The university has Wi-Fi networks both indoors and outdoors. You can connect to the internet on campus using the eduroam network.

What is eduroam?

eduroam is a secure, worldwide roaming access service developed for the research and education community. It allows students, researchers, and staff from participating institutions 1 to roam securely between the participating institutions.

How to connect to eduroam:

1. **Enable Wi-Fi:** Turn on Wi-Fi on your device.
2. **Select eduroam:** Choose the "eduroam" network from the available Wi-Fi networks.
3. **Enter credentials:** You'll need your UCM username and password to connect.
