BRIEF DESCRIPTOR

For the student of health degrees, it is essential to develop certain skills in different areas that will be essential during the exercise of their profession, especially for the dissemination and dissemination of scientific knowledge among the population and for the exchange and collaboration between professionals.

Among these skills we point out the development and enhancement of oral communication, the preparation of technical writings and their communication between professionals.

OBJECTIVES

- a) To know the fundamentals of effective oral communication.
- b) To facilitate the development and creation of a 'own brand' of speaker for the student according to their individual characteristics.
- c) To train the student to write texts in accordance with the rules of publication in scientific journals and similar.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

1. Develop teaching materials and resources adapted to the characteristics of different population groups, ages and life circumstances.
2. To effectively present discourses based on orality, both for the general population and for other health professionals in different fields: communications to congresses, health education interventions, etc.
3. Preparation of documents, articles and technical literature in general following the rules of scientific writing, with special emphasis on the preparation of reviews of all kinds with the appropriate support of sufficient bibliographic references.

TEACHING ACTIVITIES (theoretical, practical, seminars, workshops, etc.)

1. Present an oral presentation for professionals
2. To make an oral presentation for the general public
3. Write a short communication for hypothetical publication in an indexed journal or a professional conference.

CONTENT TOPICS

1. Transmission of knowledge to citizens and other professionals: materials and methodology
2. Preparation of audiovisual teaching resources.
3. Preparation of articles and scientific writing papers. Management of databases and bibliographic managers.
4. Oral presentation and scenic techniques.

EVALUATION

The evaluation of this subject is continuous and will be carried out based on:

Individual preparation of an article following the publication rules of a scientific journal (50%)

Preparation and public presentation of a short presentation (50%)

Attendance at face-to-face classes.

Proficiency in the subject will be obtained with an average grade of 5, and it is necessary to have obtained at least a five in each of the assessable parts.

The subject is eminently practical and requires the active participation of students. Attendance is mandatory and unexcused absences from scheduled classes are not allowed.
