CALL FOR PAPERS. 1st Circular Letter

The Research Projects AVIPES-CM, *Archivo Virtual para las Investigaciones sobre Patrimonios Epigráficos Medievales de la Comunidad de Madrid* (H2019/HUM-5742) and *Corpus de manuscritos de la Biblioteca Nacional de Madrid para la Historia antigua de España* (PID2019-109530GB-I00) organize an International Conference on Epigraphy on April 17-19, 2023 at the Facultad de Filología (College of Humanities), Complutense University of Madrid. The Conference focuses primarily on the epigraphic transmission, including the following topics:

- a) Epigraphic transmission of manuscripts: MS collections, indirect transmission of inscriptions, epigraphic studies in the Renaissance...
- b) Material reuse of inscriptions.
- c) Literature and Epigraphy.
- d) Forgeries, fakes and epigraphic copies.
- e) The others *tituli*: numismatics, glyptics and sigillography.

Instructions for participants:

Deadline for abstract submissions (max. 400 words) will be 12 January 2023. The official languages in the Conference are German, French, Spanish, English, Italian, Portuguese.

- Presentations will last no longer than **15 min** per participant, followed by a brief discussion moderated by an expert on the subject.
- Register fee for participants will be 60€. Register fee for attendants will be 10€ (certificated of attendance will be provided). Other attendants will not pay any fee.
- The Conference will be held face-to-face for all participants. Attendance can be held either face-to-face or online.

- A peer-reviewed collection of essays will be published as a result of the Conference. MSS will have an extension of 30 000 characters (max.) and the deadline to deliver them will be 30 June 2023.
