Her main lines of research have focused on the Soil-Plant Relationship, Desertification and Climate Change and Soil Degradation. This research activity is reflected in more than 70 scientific works in the field of Soils, direction of 4 Doctoral Theses and direction of various Undergraduate Memories, Diplomas in Advanced Studies (DEA) and various End of Master's theses. Researcher responsible in different projects and member of a team in numerous research projects, forming part of the "Fitosolum" research group, led by Professors Molina and Casermeiro. Member of the National and International Society for Soil Science.
