**(Brief Course Description)**

**Contemporary Spanish Philosophy** (Spring semester)

This course offers a general introduction to contemporary Spanish philosophy, by highlighting its uniqueness, and linking it to the European philosophical context. The course centers on the works of philosophers known as the Generation of 98, with special emphasis on the works by Miguel de Unamuno, and other important figures in twentieth-century Spanish philosophy such as José Ortega y Gasset and María Zambrano. Topics covered will include Spanish socialist thought, the philosophical contribution of Ortega y Gasset and its development through María Zambrano, and the philosophical conception of Eugenio Trías. The main objective of this course is to provide students with the knowledge to deepen their understanding of social and cultural contemporary realities.
