Introduction to Comparative Politics in Europe

A historical and comparative study of the most representative political, administrative, and economic models of Europe in the 20th and 21st centuries. The course is divided into two parts: A specific analysis of the political systems in Germany, France, Italy, the United Kingdom, and the government of the European Union, and Spain as a unique political model that since 1931 has experienced the existence or coexistence of three different political systems: The Republic, dictatorship, and constitutional monarchy. This course aims to provide the student with an overview of different political systems within the European Union and provide the necessary theoretical tools to make a comparative analysis of these systems with the political model of the United States of America.
